ORDER


The World Health Organization has declared the recent Novel Corona Virus, COVID-19 as Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) which has affected 220 Countries / Territories including India till date. WHO has characterized COVID-19 as a Pandemic on 11th March 2020.

As you are aware that COVID 19 pandemic has gripped the nation and the cases are increasing day by day. The Government of Karnataka is doing its best in containing the spread by active contact tracing, testing and adequate treatment.

As per the Karnataka Conduct of Entrance Test for Selection and Admission to Post Graduate Medical and Dental Degree and Diploma Courses (Amendment) Rules, 2018 rule 15 (V),(VI) and (VII) the candidate shall serve the Government for a period of 3 years if the Government desires.

Whereas the Karnataka Compulsory Service Training By Candidates Completed Medical Courses (Amendment) Act 2012 Section (3) for MBBS, Section (4) for Post graduates and Section (5) for Super speciality students has to undergo one year compulsory service training in Government after completion of course. This was challenged in the High court vide **WP-40566/2015** and the Honorable High Court vide its Judgement on 30-08-2019 upheld the Act – to be implemented prospectively from 24-07-2015 for students admitted for MBBS, post graduates and super specialists courses in the state.

In exercise of powers vested in me under clauses (f), (h), (j) and (l) of section 24 of the Disaster Management Act 2005 vide order of the Government number RD 158 TNR 2020 and the Epidemic diseases act, 1897, I hereby order that all the graduates , postgraduate and super specialists students graduating from the State of Karnataka shall come and report to the undersigned after their exams for postings. The Heads of institutions are directed to inform the students to report to office of DME. The Registrar, RGUHS is requested to instruct Non allopathic graduates to report to University for further needful.
